

Measures Against Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19)

In light of the recent coronavirus outbreak, Show Management has been monitoring developments closely, and we are preparing to hold the exhibition in accordance with the guidelines of the World Health Organization (WHO) and the Ministry of Health, Labor and Welfare of Japan.

The Show Management will consider that if the effects of Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) infection continue by July, coordinating with the show venue, Show Management plan to implement following measures and will hold Cafe & Wellness Week July 1st – 3rd, 2020 at PACIFICO YOKOHAMA as scheduled.

Measures planned to be implemented during the show
(As of Feb. 27)

- Alcohol-based hand rub will be set at all of the exhibition entrances
- Body temperature measurements by thermography devices at all of the exhibition entrance
In case body temperature is 37.5°C(99.5°F) or above, we may reject your entry after you submit health check sheet and go through interview by a doctor or nurse.
- Signboards to recommend Respiratory Hygiene/Cough Etiquette, Frequent Hand- washing and Wearing a mask will be put onsite.
- A doctor and nurse will be stationed at the venue during the fair.
- First-aid room will be set up inside the venue.
